Immature State	Mature State
Minimal Design Input: Limited instructional design involvement.	Progressive Development: Foundational skills with continuous upskilling and reskilling.
Static Content: Long SME recordings, hard to update.	Applied Fundamentals: Scenario-based coaching, practice, and training camps.
Basic Outcomes: Lower-order objectives with limited application.	On-the-Job Learning: Real-time, peer-to-peer, and workplace learning.
Generic Approach: One-size-fits-all training paths.	Personalized Pathways: Data-driven, individualized learning aligned to needs.
Reactive Delivery: Training introduced only after gaps emerge.	Just-in-Time Learning: Modular microlearning at the moment of need.
Limited Practice: Few opportunities for coaching or feedback.	Proactive Enablement: Training designed ahead of business needs and market shifts.
Siloed Learning: Little integration into daily workflows.	Embedded Learning: Development integrated into daily workflows and collaboration.
